

This is one of the better how to books I have used on a topic that is more art than science. It is easier to describe how to put in a sink than how to take a good picture. The text on using photoshop is also very good. I was able to take what they told me directly to my computer and I started seeing the results in my pictures immediately. While not an issue for me, it did seem to take some understanding of the topic before you have read. If your only experience is a point and shoot, it might be a struggle to read and understand what they are saying. It would be helpful to have struggled with a more advanced camera for 6 months or more.
