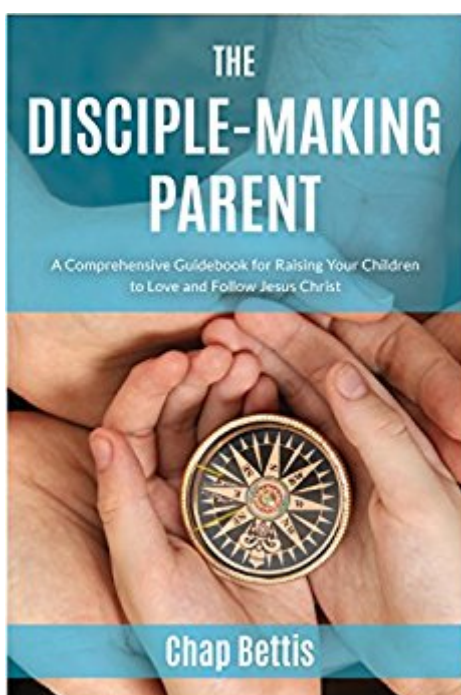

I feel so blessed to have been in a position to even hear about this book. I am actually even more blessed to have read it. I am not one who is typically a crier, and if I did, I normally would not admit it. After I began reading this book, I went to bed that night weeping. Weeping, realizing the seriousness, in God's eyes, of the gifts He has entrusted us with. As I read this comprehensive guide on spiritually guiding our children to choose the Lord and not the world, I was convicted deeply and humbled often. I was convicted, as there were some things in it that I do well, but many things not so much. I started the book and all I could think was, "This other person needs to read this." Fortunately, we serve a merciful God and good Father, who gives us wonderful gifts we do not deserve, and one of those gifts is this informative, encouraging, and Biblical book from Chap.
