

I will be sitting for the RHIT exam in November. I graduated from a 2 year HIT program in May. In the program we used the new book written by Sayles and let me tell you- that book is horrible. It's written in very fine print and the abbreviations and acronyms used abundantly throughout the entire book make it an impossible and very boring read. I much prefer Johns book which explains everything in an easy to understand manner. I am very glad I decided to purchase this book and hope it will help me pass the exam.

This edition of the book is SO MUCH more readable than the newer edition that most teachers are

requiring in their classrooms and there is a fairly small amount of additional information in the newer edition. Unless you just really want the new edition, I'd opt for this one.

Passed my exam today on the second attempt and this book was the reason why. I took so many notes. First attempt I scored a 278 and this time a 319. I would strongly recommend this book to anyone preparing for the RHIT exam :) Way better than the AHIMA prep book, don't even bother with that one it doesn't cover anything on the actual exam.

This was my first purchase from and it actually exceeded my expectations. The book was practically brand new and the disk was included which was also in good shape. I was very satisfied with my purchase. This book has been recommended by many in preparation for the RHIT exam so I thought I would give a try to locate it and I'm glad I did!!! I'm using this book for my health management class and so far this is a great book. It gives you a history on the health field, names of different organizations in the health field, it gives you reasons for the importance of Electronic Health Records and reasons why the health field is the way it is now, amongst other things. I really like that the book tests you on your understanding of the various areas of the chapter before the chapter is over. My only dislike is that some of the chapters are **VERY** long.

I passed the RHIT on yesterday. Out of all of the books I purchased this was the most helpful. This along with the PRG should be sufficient.

I purchased this book NEW. It was well written with collaboration from other parties. The CD proved unnecessary, because the items on the CD were the same as the quizzes in the book. My teacher ended up not using the quizzes in the book, nor did she use the quizzes on the CD due to the book having the answers in the back. She used alternate quizzes that did not have the answers in the back of the book. Having the answers in the back of the book only allows for students to easily cheat.
