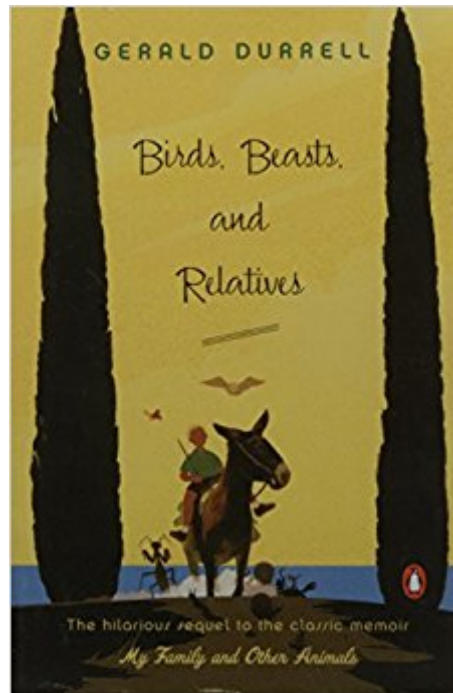

Gerald Durrell was born in Jamshedpur, India, in 1925. A student of zoology, he founded the Jersey Wildlife Preservation Trust on the Channel Island of Jersey. His other books include *A Zoo in My Luggage* and *The Whispering Land* (both available from Penguin).

Since *My Family and Other Animals* is my favorite book of all time, this is just as fun. Watching this young child's interest in science and animals grow amidst his hysterically funny family dynamic is a great diversion for the times. There is another one to get later.

One gets the feeling that time moves very slowly on Corfu and if you were land there today, it would have changed little from Gerry's stories.
