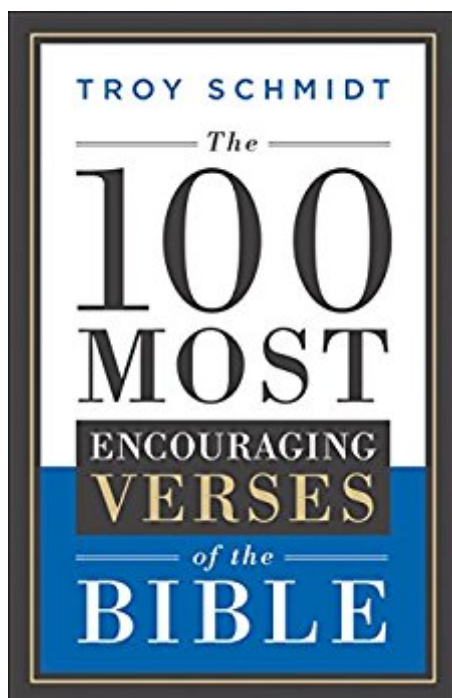

The 100 Most Encouraging Verses of the Bible is a thin, lightweight book with about 110 pages, so it can easily be taken along wherever you go. This is nice, because let's be honest, you never know when you are going to need a little encouragement as you go about your day. As the title mentions, it contains 100 different scripture passages from the Bible. In addition to reading the verses, the author also includes a brief explanation of what each passage means, and how it may be applied to the reader's life. The back of the book also includes a listing of the 100 verses mentioned throughout, so readers can also find them in the Bible at a later time. This is a convenient feature, although I do wish the page numbers were also listed next to each verse, so they can be easily referenced back in this book. What's really interesting when compared to other books like it, is that some of the author's choices of verses aren't what I would have typically deemed as encouraging, at least not initially. Of course there are some of my favorites that are taken right out of Habakkuk 3, Psalm 91 and Matthew 6, but others are not so obvious. One example would be the inclusion of Job 2:3. This verse reads: "The Lord said to Satan, 'Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man fearing God and turning away from evil. And he still holds fast his integrity, although you incited Me against him to ruin him without cause.'" Typically, this would not have been one of my top picks when seeking

encouragement from the Bible, but that is where the author's explanation of each verse comes in. When discussing Job 2:3, he explains how no matter what Satan tried to do to Job, he would not deny his faith or his Maker. The same example can be applied to our own lives, as we can demonstrate our strength and confidence in the Lord by not wavering to temptation or anger. God loves us and is in control, no matter what we're experiencing in our own personal lives. My favorite aspect of this book is that the author not only includes the verses, but offers a practical and concise breakdown of each one. This is extremely helpful when seeking that extra peace of mind. I received an advance review copy of this book to read. "all views expressed here are unbiased and purely those of my own."

I send a LOT of cards. You could say that I'm a Level 4 card sender--I probably average more than a card a day. It's one of the ways that I show love to the people I care about. And, though I've gotten pretty good at figuring out what to say, I still often find myself searching for that perfect encouraging verse that will make a difference for someone going through a tough time. So, when I saw The 100 Most Encouraging Verses of the Bible by Troy Schmidt, I thought it would be right up my alley! However...the book isn't quite what I expected--it's definitely not the categorized list of verses I thought I was choosing. Instead, the author takes a different approach. Starting in Genesis and going through to Revelation, he's chosen the 100 verses that he thinks best show the love of God for us--the verses that are the most encouraging overall in every situation. Schmidt organizes his book almost like a devotional, with the verse at the top and a short devotional style reading about the verse that gives context for the verse and ideas for applying it the midst of life. While the book wasn't what I expected, I still find it to be inspirational. The author encapsulates the theme and the mission of the book in the introduction as follows: "God loves you, He cares, and he can do something. Maybe not right now, but sometime...sooner or later. In the meantime, he offers encouragement through His word..."
