


The book was found

These stories are well written and entertaining. It's kind of Jeeves and Wooster but the aristocrat, on

this case, is not a bumbling idiot. The characters are well crafted, the plots have some twists and I did not figure out the final outcome ahead of time, which is always more satisfying. Some of the humor (they are funny, by the way) is uniquely English but translates reasonably well and the Englishness does not distract. I like them well enough to have them all and will read any future offerings.

This was another good story, except there were too many maids and other servants to keep you confused. Every guest had her own maid and the house servants were plentiful enough that you forgot who was the cook, the assistant to the cook and so on. I wish authors of these manor house stories would include a map of the house both indoor and outside. The murderer was a surprise. I thought the idea of a private race track was different.

I love this series! The characters are really good and well developed. It is a light cozy mystery and I have enjoyed all of the books so far. Look forward to the next one. I love how it takes place in a small village even though the main characters do travel around, as they do in this book. I love that it takes place in the early 1900s and how the author refers to that time often in her descriptions.

What a great fun read. Lady Hardcastle and her maid/friend/fellow south Flo are off to the races in this one. But alas, foiled again.
