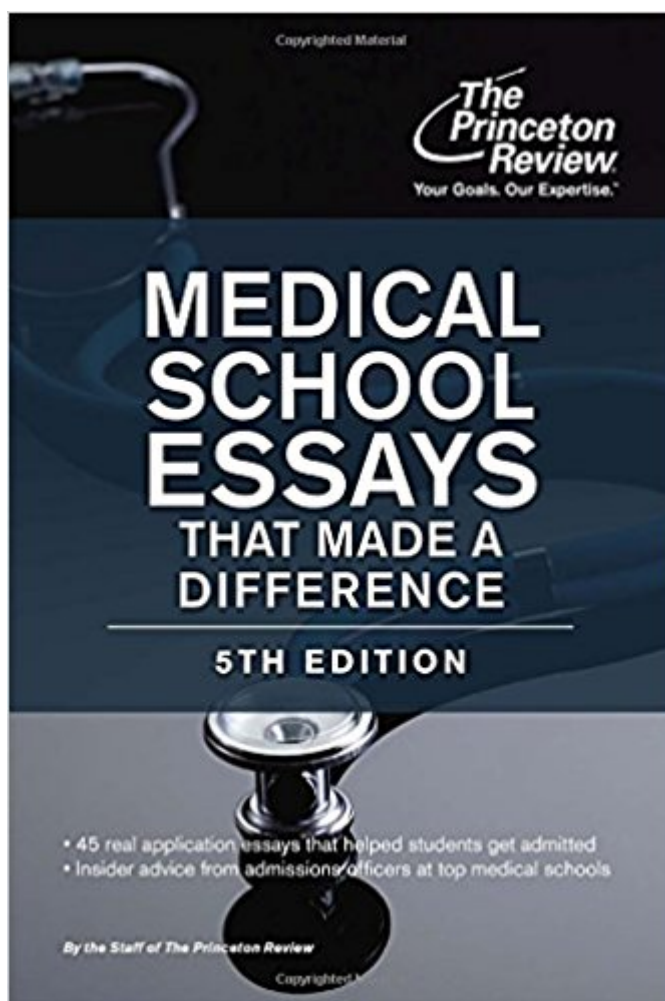

Since I bought this book to see examples of stellar essays, I was disappointed with the quality of writing. The tips offered before the essays weren't all that useful either--things anyone with common sense would know without having to shell out \$12.

I didn't like most of the essays in this book because I didn't find their narratives compelling enough. I volunteered to give feedback on personal statements on Reddit and I found even those touched me more. I gave this book a 3/5 star review, however, because some of these essays had great sentences I could model after. It especially helped me with syntax and flow of my own essay
