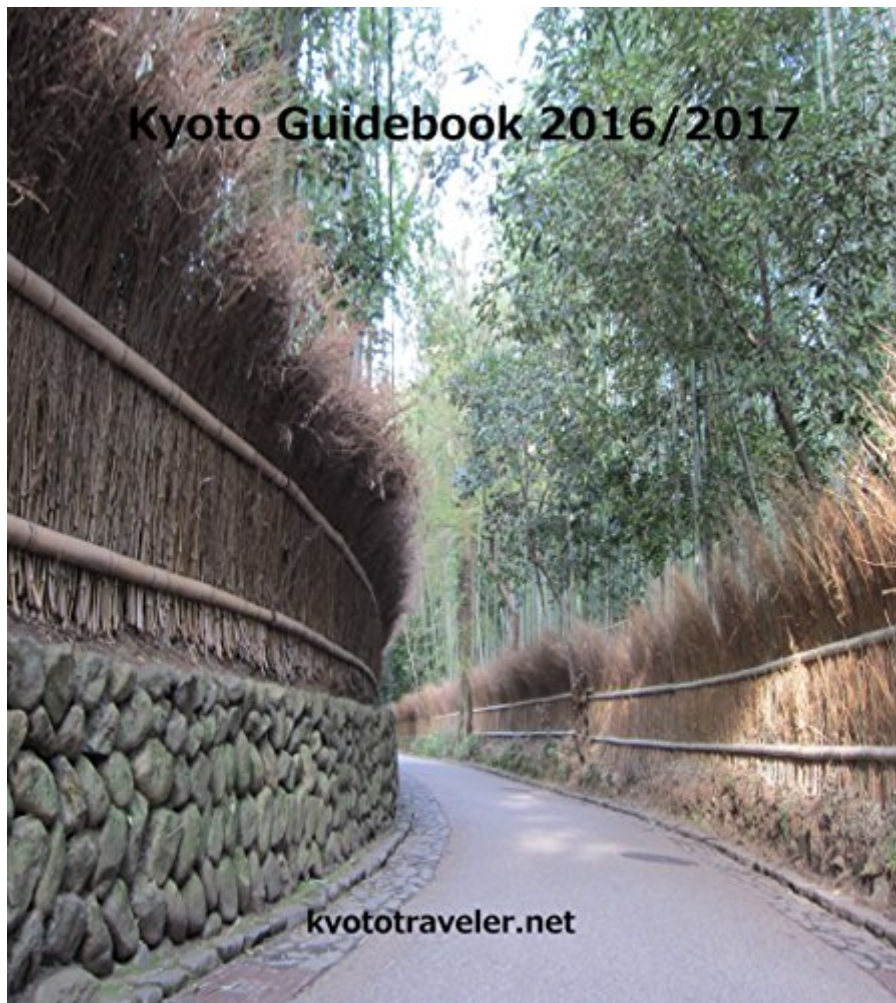

The maps could be much better, as they are very small (on an iPhone 6) and don't stay sharp when you magnify them.
