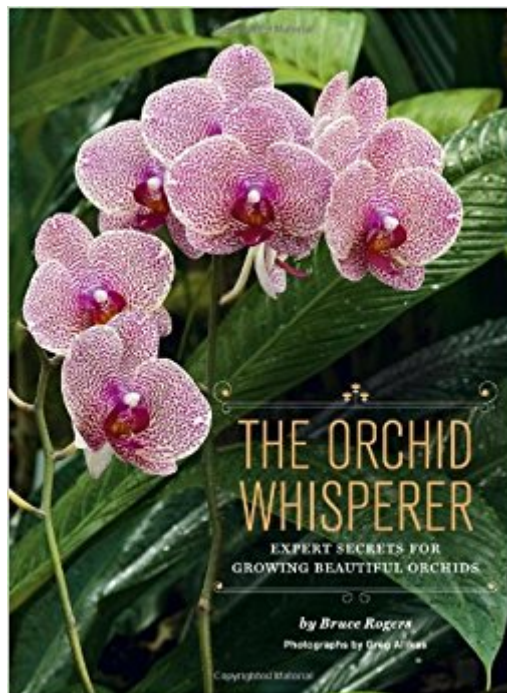




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The Orchid Whisperer: Expert Secrets For Growing Beautiful Orchids

I love this new book with tips about growing orchids! I enjoy experimenting with various orchids but am often frustrated when I can't coax them into re-blooming. Rogers offers advice in a very readable and doable format. My favorite advice is in the cymbidium section. I have 40 or so cymbidiums in my collection. Dividing and re-potting is a challenge that I often put aside for 'next year'. Roger advises, "My advice is to learn how to re-pot cymbidium, then find a job that pays well enough that you can hire someone to re-pot your cymbidiums." My resume is available.

The photos are spectacular! I found myself mentally moving some of my plants based on the artistic arrangements in the photos. If you have a few orchids hanging around just waiting to be encouraged to thrive, this book is for

you.

I appreciate this book so much. Very glad to have purchased before attempting to buy and maintain orchids. I actually changed my mind, for the time being, as I am now able to critique orchards at shops and big box stores. And heavens so, the poor beauties are normally on terrible condition. Advice given by workers in the store is usually wrong. Ice cubes in the soil is wrong!! Plus I now know about the correct conditions, location in my home and how to water, re-pot and provide adequate rainforest conditions. Very interesting and do-able. The varieties, beautiful pictures and decorative ideas are also great. Glad I didn't jump in without reading this book!! Unfortunately, I really have no suitable room in my present home, but that doesn't mean at some point the demographics won't change. Knowledge is power!

I purchased this book based on 's reviews, and I was surprised at how unexceptional it is. The section of the book dedicated to specific types of orchids is adequate, though sparse. The more general information on orchid culture is presented amateurishly, with sidebars containing dubiously-researched "facts" and vaguely-described techniques likely to end in failure for inexperienced growers. There are no "secrets" in this book, and nothing that you won't find in greater detail with clearer instructions in the many other books on growing orchids. I was also disappointed there was no information on flaked orchids. I suggest purchasing Understanding Orchids, by William Cullina, instead of this volume. Cullina's book contains all the reliable instruction in The Orchid Whisperer plus a good bit more, and is detailed enough and organized as to be practical for the home grower.

Comments on the cover of The Orchid Whisperer state that Bruce Rogers "covers everything you need to know to grow healthy orchids that will bloom again and again." As members of a family of successful orchid growers, I agree that Rogers has achieved his goal. Information about "everything you need to know" wisely begins with suggestions for purchasing a suitable plant and getting it settled in your home. He describes orchid varieties that

are not place minimal demands on their caregivers and are most likely to produce long-lasting flowers. A plant unsuited to the level of its grower's care or its new environment will not thrive. This information is essential for the beginning orchid grower but may be omitted from books written for more experienced growers. His sections on the different varieties include brief descriptions of the plants and easy-to-follow directions for their care. Photos illustrate the glossary as well as directions for repotting and other procedures. The photos of individual plants and plant displays are beautiful. The book can be enjoyed not only by novice orchid growers but also by those interested in learning more about orchids.

An easy to follow book for the beginner (like me) who wants to be successful growing orchids... I have failed before! I even bought another copy to give a friend who is a beginner too. We both caught the 'orchid bug' at a local orchid show in the Chicago area. It will become my go-to book!
