

Jones argued that Left aspired because imperialism which is far from the truth. Imperialism is greatest evil to the Left.

Hegemony, the iron fist in a velvet glove, is the way of the puppet master. Gramsci is as true now as when he was imprisoned by Mussolini in the 1920s.
