

Napoleon Hill was born in 1883 in a one-room cabin on the Pound River in Wise County, Virginia. He began his writing career at age 13 as a "mountain reporter" for small town newspapers and went on to become America's most beloved motivational author. He passed away in November 1970

after a long and successful career writing, teaching, and lecturing about the principles of success. Hill established the Napoleon Hill Foundation as a non-profit educational institution whose mission is to perpetuate his philosophy of leadership, self-motivation, and individual achievement.

This book is the actual conversation between Napoleon Hill and Andrew Carnegie that took place in 1908. It was the basis for the Law of Success and Think and Grow Rich. If you have read those books, then this book is of value to you. If you haven't then this book will be a great starting point for all your Napoleon Hill reading. I also have the audio of this book and listen to it in combination with the text! A must have if you love Napoleon Hill's work.
