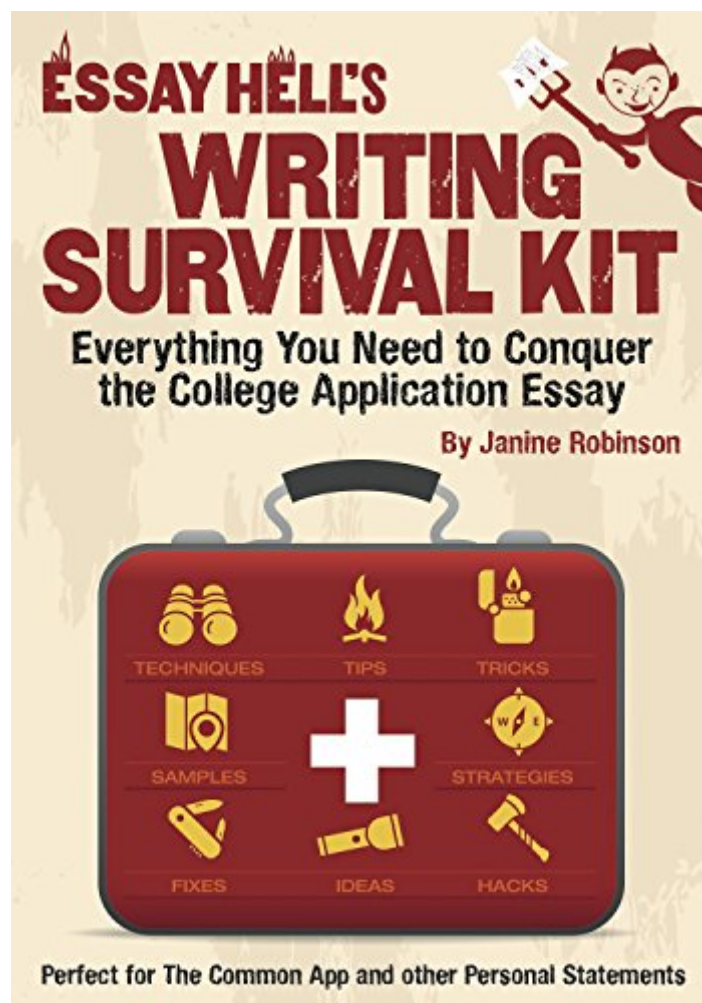




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Essay Hell's Writing Survival Kit: Everything You Need To Conquer The College Application Essay

I read this book after going through Janine Robinson's guide 'Escape Essay Hell', and expected it to be redundant. Surprisingly, both books offer different perspectives as well as fresh advice. 'Escape Essay Hell' is written in a much more light-hearted style while it guides students with the specific steps to follow for a winning essay. This book on the other hand, is written in a more serious tone and deeply explains what qualities make a good college essay and why. An awesome companion to the process of essay crafting! This guide does not teach you to be a good writer. It teaches you to be a good application essay writer as all the concepts inside are tailored to meet the "criteria" of an effective college application essay. You may ask, "What's the difference between this guide and *Escape Essay Hell*?" Well, unlike Janine's previous guide "*Escape Essay Hell*", this guide does not tell you how to write your essay in detailed steps. Rather, it lists out all the qualities of a good application essay. I highly recommend reading this book before writing for an idea of the expectations of a good essay. I also recommend reading this book again after writing your essay drafts as a quality-control check list.

I've been a big fan of Janine's work ever since I started reading her blog posts over a year ago. As a college counselor and former college admissions counselor, I understand all too well just how important the essay can be in a student's application yet how challenging it can be to write an essay that truly conveys something of significance about the student. And I'm not talking about Earth shattering, life altering moments here. Rather, the best essays are born of random moments, issues, struggles, accomplishments - every day type of things that students often overlook when they try to come up with an idea. Janine's guide takes students step by step through this process whether they already have an idea and are trying to figure out how to start their essay or if they have no idea where to start at all. *The Essay Hell Writing Survival Kit* is a must-read for any college applicant who is struggling with their essay. And let's be honest, they all do at one point or another.

Before we discovered Janine's blog and her books *Essay Hell* as well as the *Survival Kit*, we had purchased every other book to try and understand for our oldest daughter how to write a college essay and how to choose a topic that would not cause a college admissions officer to roll their eyes in boredom. The other books we purchased for my child were either so basic as to be worthless or quite frankly, so esoteric as to be of no assistance. My complaint is that a number of the well known

books on this topic are written by former admission professionals or counselors who are unable to relate to a very busy high school senior who is trying to juggle academics and the college application process. I felt many of the books we purchased discuss the theory of an essay but never really helped the student walk through how to write the essay. In other words, the other books tell the student what to do, not how to write the essay. Essay Hell and The Writing Survival Kit. Both books are informative and most importantly walk the applicant through the essay writing process. Janine actually helps them find a topic by getting them to focus on a singular incident or event that leads to a broader discussion. My daughter read threw the books and instantly understood what she needed to do to craft an essay that was reflective of her. Lastly, what I love about the process is that Janine actually helps the student find their own unique voice instead of producing an over polished or canned essay.
